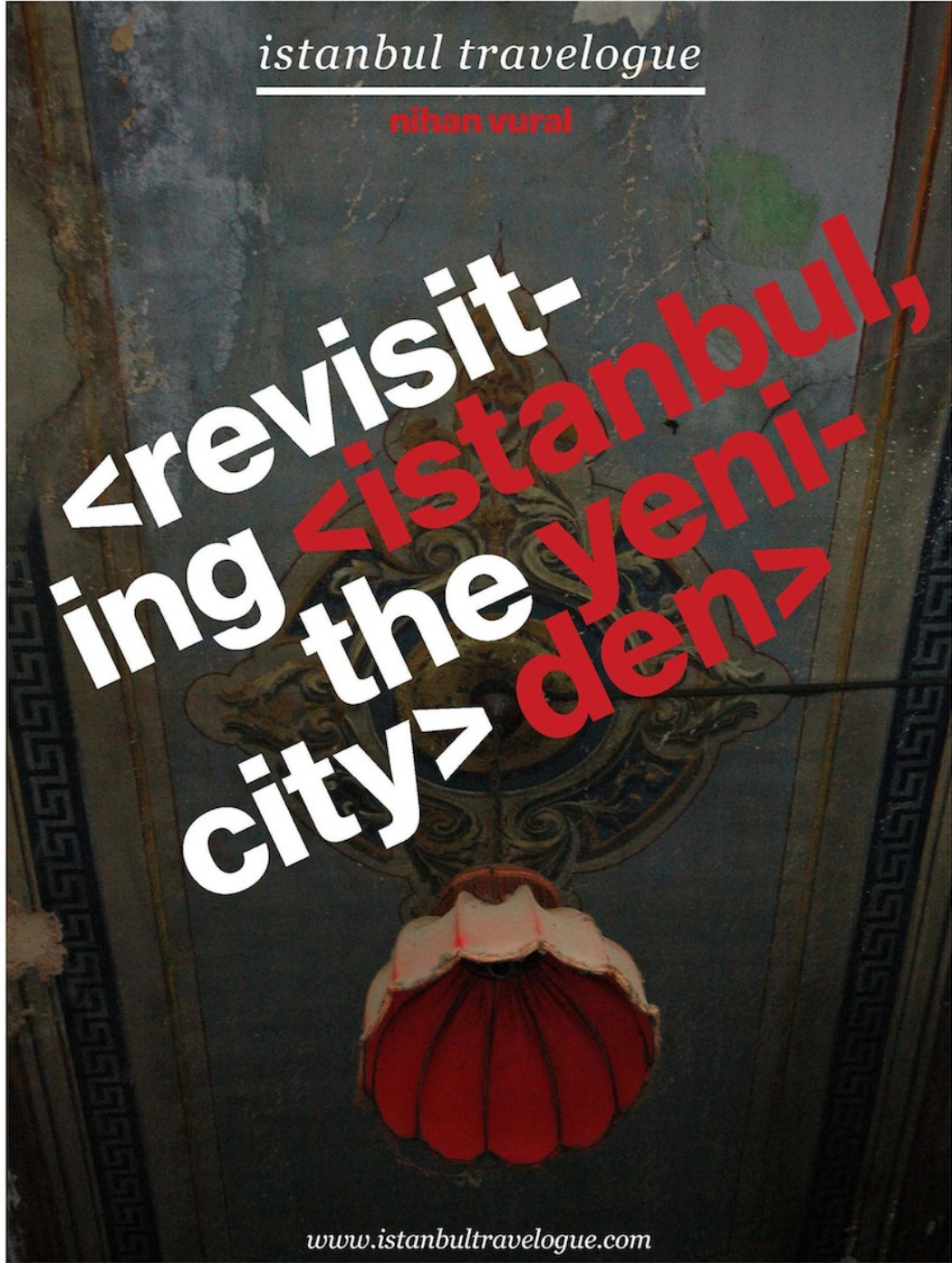

The photos and texts she compiled from her personal blog, *Istanbul Travelogue*, question the possibility of existing in spaces where we, Istanbulites, feel fragile and of a deeper integration in the context of a transforming city. “*The way to straighten out our relationship with the city would be revisiting the city with a fresh perspective; recognizing our unofficial history, and the inheritance of our ghosts, while coming to terms with whatever we perceive as a threat to our way of being and meeting in our common denominator; humanity.*” summarizes the challenges we take on as Istanbulites and introduces us to our home once again. The exhibition will run from Monday, August, 19 through Thursday, September, 19 2013.
